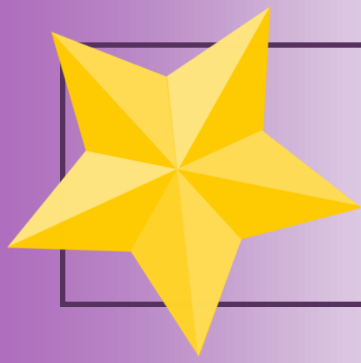

Reminders:
